Gender sensitization is promoted through co-curricular activities like workshops, guest lectures, counseling, etc. The female staff of the institute has been given representation on various committees of the institute. They have been made chairwomen of some of the committees of the institution. In the National Service Scheme of the institute also female students participate in all the activities. All the staff and students that is male and female collectively celebrate national festivals and birth and death anniversaries of great men/women and leaders of the country. In all curricular, co-curricular, and extracurricular activities conducted by the institute, all male and female staff and students participate equally. International Women's Day is celebrated every year by the institute with great zeal and enthusiasm. The Women Grievance Redressal Cell looks after the grievances of girl students. This committee with the help of all the teachers and students celebrates regularly these days and events like - 3 January -Savitribai Phule Birth anniversary, 12 January-National Youth Day- Swami Vivekananda Birth Anniversary, This day is celebrated as Youth Day 26 January-Republic day, 30 January Day Death anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi, 19 February –Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj's birth anniversary, 8 March-International Women's day, 14 April-Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Birth Anniversary, 1 MayMaharashtra Day, 15 August-Independence Day, 5 September-Teachers' day - Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishna Birth nniversary, etc
