Sant Dnyaneshwar stated confidently about sweetness and poetical qualities of Marathi Language. Marathi language is being spoken in everyday life in daily communication, and speeches. Man has created Marathi Language but Marathi language has created humanity (human qualities) in man. Marathi Language has given culture to our society.

The famous poet (V.M.Kulkarni) appreciatin sweetness and beauty of Marathi Language writes,

‘Mazya Marathichi godi

Mala watate avit

Mazya Marathicha chand

Mana nitya Mohavit.

The famous essayist in Marathi Chiplunkar compares Marathi language with milk of Lioness. Many Marathi writers like (V.S.Khandekar, V.V.Shirwadkar) have won Sahitya Academy Prize for their literacy contribution.

Since 1956 Marathi has served as the official language of the Maharashtra state. Marathi is most commonly written using Devanagri script. Marathi has and impression literary tradition dating from aout 1100 A.D. The start of Marathi language literary culture was in part due to adoption of the Marathi language by two religious sants, - the Warkari and Mahanubhava. The

poetry and prose published by members of these religious sants marked the beginnings of literary Marathi language tradition.

Further growth of Marathi literature was promoted with the rise of Yadava Dynasty which help to prosper this language for art in the form of prose, poetry, drama. Etc.

For about three hundred years the literature was mainly religious and philosophical in spirit Mukundarajas Viveka Sindhu is considered to be the first major work in the Marathi language. The Bhakti movement and produced the great Dnyandeva whose Bhavarth Dipik (the Dnyaneshwari) and amritanubhava are standard religious book of Maharashtrians. Namdev and Eknath were other poets in the same tradition of Marathi language. Sant Tukaram wrote more than 3000 Abhang which are till date studied by researches not only in India but also in the whole world.

Marathi literature is contributed not only by Maharashtrians but also by outsiders like the Father Stephen who was of Portugus origin. In 1614 he wrote 'Khistripuran' in Marathi.

It can be quoted by father Stelphen in the praise of

“Jaisi puspamaji pushpamogari

ki parimala mazi kastruri

Taisi Bhasamaji Sajiri Marathi”

Saint Shekh Mohammad in his 'Yogsangram' have praised Marathi language, as,

“yati musalman | Maharashtra | Maharashtra

Aikati Awadine | viprashudra”

In The region of Nizamshah Ahmednagar and Adilshah of Vaijapur Marathi was their official language due to universal approach of Marathi language.

The famous poet of Marathi Kusumagraj who was awarded Dnyanpith Purskar, his birthday is celebrated as ‘Marathi Bhasha Din’ For progress and cultivation of Marathi language State Government is also taking steps. Marathi literature is rich and complete. The history of Marathi language compels on the think about language science, Alphabets and child literature.

Though it is considered that man has created language but Marathi language has contributed in creation of being human. Marathi literature is being translated in various languages. Sant Dnyaneshwar & Sant Tukarams religious literature curved the path of humanity. Marathi language have a peaceful melodies its ornamentations is its beauty-famous poet N.G.Nardapurkar’s “May Marathi” this poem shows the immense love for Marathi language.
